



## Marlin L. Houser

June 27, 1923 - February 8, 2009

Marlin L. Houser, 85, of Lebanon died Sunday, February 8, 2009, in his residence. Born in Heilmandale on June 27, 1923, he was the son of the late Harry F. and Lizzie Strohman Houser. He was a retired welder from the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, and a U.S. Army veteran of World War II. Marlin was a 1941 graduate of Lebanon High School; a member of Hill United Church of Christ since 1937, where he served as a trustee, was secretary of the Sunday school department, and a member of the Men's and Ladie's Bible Class. He was also a member of Mt.
