Marlin D. Nye, 73, of Cleona, passed away on Monday, April 16, 2018, at the WellSpan Good Samaritan Hospital, surrounded by his loving family. He was the husband of Joanne F. Smith Nye. On January 10th, they celebrated their 43rd wedding anniversary.

Born in Lickdale on December 28, 1944, he was the son of the late George and Grace Ulrich Nye. Marlin had worked at the former Lebanon Steel Foundry and then retired from the Navy Depot. He served in the U.S. Army and was a Seabee in the Navy Reserve. He attended the Lebanon Gospel Center. 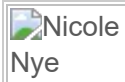
