



## Mary E. Brubaker

February 9, 1928 - December 29, 2019

Mary E. Brubaker, 91, of Hershey died Sunday, December 29, 2019 in the M. S. Hershey Medical Center. She was the wife of Dr. Warren W. Brubaker with whom she celebrated 69 years of marriage.

Born in Philadelphia on February 9, 1928, she had a fondness for the small town of Narbreth and was the daughter of the late John and Mildred Warner Baily. She was a homemaker, but in her earlier years, she worked for Penn Salt in Philadelphia, AMP in Harrisburg, and for Penn Dot in Harrisburg.

Mary was a 1946 graduate of Lower Merion High School. She was a member of the First United Methodist Church of Hershey and its Circle of Hope, the Annville LVC Forum, and was excellent at short-hand and stenography.
