Tillie was born on Armistice Day, November 6, 1918, on the Blue Rock Farm in Ono, East Hanover Twp., Lebanon County, PA to the late David and Ruth V. (Crouse) Peiffer. She was the wife of the late John William Prehoda who died July 2, 1989. Tillie was a 1936 graduate of Annville High School and a 1938 graduate of Lebanon Business College. She was a career woman working at Indiantown Gap and A. E. Twigg until her retirement when she plunged whole heartedly into the pursuit of genealogy, She was a life member of the Lebanon County Historical Society, Historic Preservation Trust of Lebanon County, Tulpehocken Settlement Society, Pioneer Historical Society of Bedford County, Fulton County Historical Society, Inc., and John Conrad Weiser Family Association. Tillie was the last of her immediate family having been preceded in death by one sister, Ruth, and two brothers, Edward and Paul.
