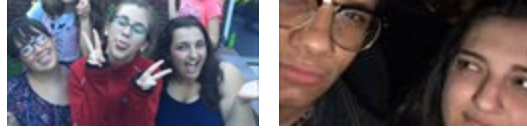

“ I became close with Megan a few years ago, when I lived in Tampa. She was having a hard time coping at that point and went inpatient for awhile and switched schools. It always seemed to me that Megan was too mature and too pure for lame high school and I tried to help her set her sights on the future - college was not like that. She overcame her struggles on her own though and really loved the school she transferred to and the friends she made. We talked often through text and Messenger because I live in Pittsburgh, but last summer I had the good fortune to see her in person at our family reunion. Even more fortunately, my daughter and nieces and nephew got to meet her. We were all immediately taken with her light and her sweet angelic voice and soul. She was so excited about a peer counseling course she would be taking, which she successfully completed shortly thereafter. We talked often of her plans, and she began giving me advice, too. She always remained calm and clearheaded and I had never heard her speak a word in anger. After a few months, Megan had her own apartment and job and a cat. She wanted to go to Pitt and work at Western Psych while she earned her degree in Psychology. On her own, she found a program that she could take from home until she could complete the credits necessary to transfer to Pittsburgh. She said 2019 was going to be our year and was doing everything she could for herself to make it that way. I am devastated Megan has passed so young with so much promise.
