Michael A. "Mike" Stefonich, 75, of Lebanon passed away Saturday, September 30, 2023 surrounded by his family. He was the husband of Beverly A. (Fasnacht) Stefonich to whom he was married 50 years.

Born in Cornwall, he was the son of the late Michael J. and Mary (Wolf) Stefonich. Mike graduated from Cedar Crest High School and retired after 39 years from the City of Lebanon as a highway superintendent.
