



## Michael Henry Cooper Jr.

Michael Henry Cooper, Jr., 44, of Grantville, went home to be with the Lord on Saturday, October 21, 2017.

Born in Hoboken, NJ, on November 14, 1972, he was the son of Michael H. Cooper, Sr., of Scotch Plains, NJ, and Althea J. McCabe of Matheson, CO. He grew up in New Jersey where he graduated from Scotch Plains-Fanwood High School in 1991.

Michael showed an interest in the military in high school, where he participated in the U.S. Air Force Jr. ROTC program and the Navy ROTC. While in the Navy ROTC, he received the New Jersey Governor Award. He then enlisted in the U.S. Navy and served for 4 years. He was currently serving in the PA Army National Guard. Michael was involved with the Friends of Gettysburg. He also had an interest in helping orphans, which led him to mission trips to Russia and Haiti.

In addition to his parents, he is survived by his brother, sister-in-law, a niece, two nephews and other family and friends.

A memorial service will be held on Tuesday, October 31, 2017, at 1:00 p.m. at the Kreamer & Lum Funeral Home & Crematory, Rt. 72 & Camp Meeting Rd., Jonestown. There will be no viewing, but a visitation will be held beginning at 11:00 a.m. Interment will follow at the Indiantown Gap National Cemetery.

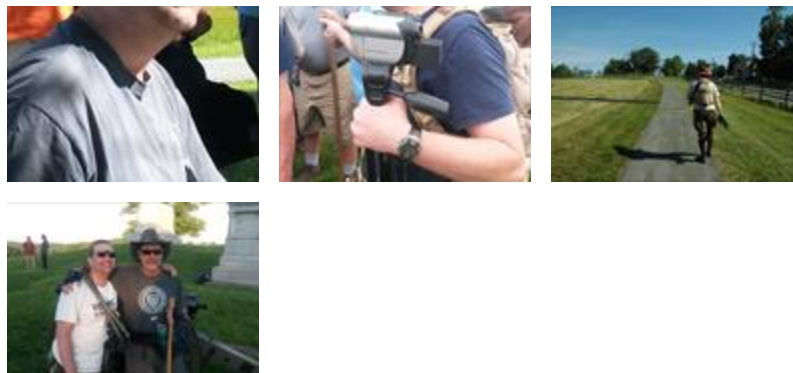

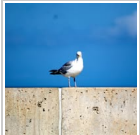
