Michael K. Schrader, 73, of Annville passed away on Thursday, May 30, 2019 in the Hospice Unit at the Lebanon VA Medical Center. He was the husband of Sue Anne Foltz Schrader to whom he was married 52 years.

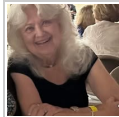
