



## Michael J. Wallace

October 15, 1943 - August 25, 2021

Michael J. Wallace, 77, of Lebanon died Wednesday, August 25, 2021 at the Lebanon VA Medical Center.

Born in Norfolk, VA on October 15, 1943, he was the son of the late Frederick H. Gunkel and the late Juneau A. Hoen. Michael was a Veteran of the United States Army during the Vietnam War where he completed two tours with the 173rd Airborne BDE. He considered himself a native of Reno, Nevada, where he graduated from the University of Nevada-Reno with his Bachelor of Science degree. He later obtained his Master of Arts at the University of Nebraska. Michael enjoyed shooting, traveling, museums, sailing on Lake Tahoe, and sharing all his stories. He was a volunteer fireman in Frisco, Texas. Michael retired from the Army National Guard with the rank of Master Sergeant.

Surviving is his wife, Teresa Wallace of Lebanon, two stepsons, Ricardo Ramos-Martin, fiancée of Kelsey Hurley of Lancaster, Tomas Ramos-Martin of Hawaii, and a daughter, Erin Michalak of British Columbia, Canada. He is preceded in death by his sister, Sylvia (Gunkel) Widdicombe.
