Mildred N. Fisher, 97, of the Lebanon Valley Home, Annville, formerly of 643 E. Maple Street, Annville, died Friday, July 24, 2009, in the home. She was the wife of the late William W. Fisher, who died in 1969. Born in Annville on March 26, 1912, she was the daughter of the late John G. and Lizzie V. Kreider Nye. She was employed as a Clerk for Bethlehem Steel Corp., Lebanon, and also worked as an Assistant Librarian at the Annville Elementary School. Millie was the last surviving member of the 1930 graduating class of Annville High School and a 1934 graduate of Lebanon Valley College.
