Mildred Anna Brubaker "Millie" Shade died peacefully on May 19, 2013 at the Lebanon Valley Brethren Home, Palmyra, PA. She was the wife of the late Thomas W. "Bill" Shade. She married Staff Sergeant Thomas W. (Bill) Shade in Ft. Wayne, Indiana immediately before Bill was deployed in the Philippine Islands during WW II.
