



## Mildred Florence (Moyer) Peiffer

Mildred Florence (Moyer) Peiffer, 105, formerly of 619 Hill Street, Lebanon, died Monday, August 1, 2016 in the Lebanon Valley Home, Annville. She was the wife of the late Lee D. Peiffer who died in 2006. Born in Richland on May 25, 1911, she was the daughter of the late Horace G. and Florence (Smaltz) Moyer. She was an elementary school teacher at West Lebanon School from 1931-1940 and later taught at the Mifflin School in Lebanon from 1940-1943. Mildred was a 1929 graduate of Lebanon High School and a 1931 graduate of the former Millersville State Teacher's College. She was a member of St. Mark's United Church of Christ, Lebanon, where she taught Sunday school; Gideon's International Auxiliary, and Christian Endeavor in the 1930's and 1940's. Surviving are two daughters: Patricia, wife of John Beamenderfer of Fredericksburg, Marjorie Garrett of Carlisle; a son Robert B. Peiffer of Ephrata, four grandchildren: Katie, wife of Tyler Prickett; Molly Peiffer, Andrew Peiffer, and Nicholas Peiffer; a great-grandson, Elijah Lee Prickett, and a sister, Marian Walker of Exton. In addition to her husband, she was preceded in death by an infant daughter; two brothers, Ray G. Moyer and Horace F. "Bud" Moyer, and an infant granddaughter, Mary Ellen Beamenderfer. Funeral services will be held on Saturday at 10:00 a.m. in the Chapel of the Lebanon Valley Home, 550 E. Main Street, Annville. Interment will be in Mt. Lebanon Cemetery.
