



## Norman G. Gingrich

Norman G. Gingrich, 94, of 100 Cottage Drive, Apt. 107, Palmyra died Monday September 19, 2011 in the Lebanon Valley Brethren Home, Palmyra. He was the husband of the late Naomi White Gingrich who died in 2005 to whom he was married to for 65 years.
