Norman Sanger, a sinner saved by God's grace, went to be with his Lord and Savior on Friday, August 13, 2021 surrounded by his family.

Norm, known to his friends and family as "Butch", was born November 28, 1949 in Lebanon, Pa. He was the son of Clarence & Naomi (Longenecker) Sanger, who both preceded him in death. Also preceding him in death was his brother Joseph Sanger (wife Rosa), Lebanon. Norm is survived by his wife Miriam (Yeakley) Sanger, to whom he was married 50 years.
