Patricia Mae Poloney (nee Drobile) of Annville, PA, 90 years young, gently passed away on September 7, 2019 surrounded by loving family. Patricia was born in Philadelphia, PA on March 17, 1929 and lived her early life in Roxborough. Patricia graduated from Hallahan High School with top honors and was a Children's Librarian at the Free Library of Philadelphia in center city. After her marriage she worked for the American Red Cross in Washington, DC before moving to Annville, PA in 1956 and raising her large family. She additionally taught kindergarten at St. Mary's Regional School and later worked for Thousand Trails Campground as the office manager. Patricia's great joy was time for her family. She shared her many passions with them and taught them the joy of working with their hands. Her interests included gardening, bird watching, knitting, crocheting, sewing, baking cookies, and cross stitch. Her great love was time at the beach where she fished with her husband and body surfed with her grandchildren. In addition, she had a "second family" at St. Paul the Apostle Roman Catholic church in Annville where she participated as a member of the Parish Council of Catholic Women, lectured, participated in the Prayer Shawl ministry, the altar linen ministry and Faith Sharing. Patricia's memory is held by her spouse, Peter, of 66 years, her 7 children and their spouses, her 24 grandchildren and 6 great grandchildren.
