Patricia W. Ulishney, 74, of Lebanon, died Monday, October 30, 2017 at Wellspan Good Samaritan Hospital. She was the wife of Francis E. Ulishney to whom she was married 51 years.

Born in Greensburg, PA on December 4, 1942, she was the daughter of the late Clarence Perry and Estella (Shoaf) Weaver. Patricia graduated from Greensburg Salem High School in 1962, and went on to work for the Medical Personnel Pool, various nursing homes and was a Certified Home Health Aide.
