



Paul A. LeVan, Jr.

April 4, 1947 - March 16, 2024

Paul A. LeVan, Jr., 76, of North Lebanon Twp., passed away peacefully on Saturday, March 16, 2024, at WellSpan Good Samaritan Hospital, Lebanon. He was the husband of Mary Ann Malinowski LeVan. On February 24th, they celebrated their 51st wedding anniversary.

Born in Wilmington, DE on April 4, 1947, he was the son of the late Paul A. Sr., and Emma Hutchison LeVan. He graduated from Wm. Penn High School, New Castle, DE with the Class of 1966. Following high school, he served in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam Conflict. He then went on to serve 30 years in the U.S. Army National Guard and retired as SFC. Paul was a civilian employee with the Dept. of Defense and retired from the Indiantown Gap Fire Dept. He was a salaried employee of the American Red Cross, and he also volunteered for them for 51 years. He was a member of the American Legion, a life member of the VFW and a member of the Rescue Hose #4. He taught CPR and First Aid with the Red Cross. He enjoyed fishing, camping, and traveling with his wife.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by his daughter Christine L. wife of Shon Shellehamer of Lebanon; son Paul A. LeVan, III, of Lebanon; sisters Mary Ellen Veid of New Castle, DE, and Virginia Scott of MD; sister-in-law Marilyn LeVan of Bear, DE; four grandchildren and five great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his brothers John and Joseph LeVan and sister Dorothy Lambdin.

Funeral services will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Monday, March 25, 2024, at the
