Paul R. Shuey, 90, of the Countryside Christian Community, and formerly of E. Hanover Twp., passed away on Thursday, April 5, 2012, at the home. He was the husband of the late Arlene J. Heck Shuey. Born in E. Hanover Twp., on September 5, 1921, he was the son of the late Elmer and Annie Ruth Shuey.
