February 1, 1918 - December 1, 2008

Pauline L. "Polly" Worcester, 90, formerly of Cleona died Monday, December 1, 2008, in the Lebanon Valley Home, Annville. She was the wife of the late Elra A. Worcester, who died in 1976. Born in Lebanon on February 1, 1918, she was the daughter of the late Ira and Naomi Ebright Wentling. She worked as a clerk at the former King's Department Store, Cleona, for 30 years, and then as a cook for the Countryside Christian Community, Annville.
