Pearl A. Miller, 87, of 44 S. White Oak Street, Annville died Saturday January 19, 2013 in the Palmyra Nursing Home. She was the wife of Charles W. Miller to whom she was married 65 years. Born in Weavertown on November 9, 1925, she was the daughter of the late Abraham and Lizzie Donmoyer Blouch. She was employed in sales for Sarah Coventry Fashion Jewelry. Pearl attended Fredericksburg High School and was a member of Christ Church United Church of Christ, Annville where she sang in the choir for 25 years. She was the co-founder and past president of the Annville VFW Post Auxiliary and for over 60 years served the Salvation Army in Lebanon as Chairlady of the Annville area.
