Quentin T. Hall, 27, formerly of Annville, went home to be with the Lord after a long battle with cancer, on Sunday, March 3rd, 2024, at the M.S. Hershey Medical Center, surrounded by his loving family.

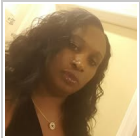

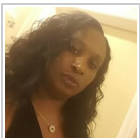
