Reed P. O'Neal, 53, of 1742 Thompson Avenue, Lebanon, died Monday October 18, 2010 from injuries sustained after being hit by a vehicle in the 600 block of East Main Street, Annville. He was the husband of Cynthia L. Strickler O'Neal. Born in Lebanon on October 29, 1956, he was the son of Russell and Trisha Kirchoffer O'Neal of Annville. He worked as a sub-contractor for the Harrisburg Patriot News since 1975 and also was employed by the Manheim Auto Auction. Reed was a 1975 graduate of Annville-Cleona High School. Surviving in addition to his wife and parents are a son Reed P. O'Neal, II at home, a daughter Kyra E. O'Neal of Sellersville, PA, two brothers Ricki "Chip" O'Neal of Cornwall, Randi "Gus" O'Neal of Jonestown, and a sister Pamela O'Neal of New Mexico. Memorial services will be held on Thursday at 10:00 AM from the Kreamer Funeral Home and Crematory, 618 E. Main Street, Annville. Interment will be held at the convenience of the family. Visitation will be held from 9-10 AM prior to the service at the funeral home.
