Richard D. Fortna, 80, of Jonestown, passed away on Thursday, November 25, 2010, at his home. He was the husband of the late Grace D. Daub Fortna. Born in Jonestown, on April 16, 1930, he was the son of the late Clayton H. and Annie M. Bohn Fortna. He farmed his whole life, but also worked in various other areas. He worked in maintenance at the Good Samaritan Hospital, and for several years he drove school bus and he also drove charter bus for the Lebanon Bus Co. He was also a member of the PA State Grange and the National Grange. He was one of the original members of the Herald Quartet.
