Richard Henry Meily, 94, of Lebanon, passed away on October 3 2016, in Palm Harbor, Florida. He was the husband of the late Lois (Haas) Meily, who passed away in 2014.

Rich was born in Lebanon on January 18, 1922 to the late Robert and Maggie Strohman Meily. He was a veteran of WWII and was retired from Bethlehem Steel. After retirement, Rich enjoyed raising Charolais cattle on his beloved Twin Lock Farm. Rich was well known in the community as the Ebenezer Teener League Baseball head coach for over 50 years. He was inducted into the Pennsylvania Sports Hall of Fame and was honored by having the Ebenezer Teener League baseball field named after him.

Surviving are his children, Eileen Bermudez, Richard D. Meily, Christine Foreman, and Jo Ellyn Ruscigno, eight grandchildren, three great grandchildren, a brother Joseph and a sister Alverta.
