Richard H. Ulrich, 87, formerly of Ono died Friday February 27, 2015 in the Lebanon Valley Brethren Home, Palmyra. He was the husband of Mary G. Dutweiler Ulrich with whom he would have celebrated their 65th wedding anniversary this April.

Born in Lebanon on April 8, 1927, he was the son of the late Hershey and May Paine Ulrich. He was retired from Hershey Foods Corp. after 46 years of service.
