Richard J. Wasserman, aka "Dipper Dan" of 1811 Carlton Drive, Lebanon, died Saturday, February 21, 2009, in the Lebanon VA Medical Center. He was the husband of Phoebe M. Cooper Wasserman, with whom he would have celebrated their 53rd wedding anniversary this May. Born in Brooklyn, N.Y., on January 29, 1931, he was the son of the late Bernard and Esther Magid Wasserman.
