Richard A. Yancoskie, 68, of 96 Auburn Drive, Annville died Wednesday January 28, 2015 from injuries sustained in an automobile accident in South Lebanon Twp. He was the husband of Rose Marie Clerico Yancoskie with whom he celebrated their 44th wedding anniversary on January 16, 2015.

Born in Charleston, MA on October 9, 1946, Richard grew up in Shamokin, PA and was the son of the late Albert and Florence Letvage Yancoskie. He retired after 28 years as an accounting manager for Alcoa, Lebanon. He then started his own tax and bookkeeping service.

Richard was a US Army Veteran of Vietnam and a 1964 graduate of Our Lady of Lourdes High School, Shamokin. He was a member of St. Paul the Apostle Church, Annville where he served on the Parrish Council and a Eucharistic Minister. He was a loving husband, father, and grandfather.
