



## Robert H. Neidlinger

May 4, 1927 - September 17, 2013

Robert H. Neidlinger, 86, of Jonestown, passed away on Tuesday, September 17, 2013, at the Lebanon Good Samaritan Hospital. He was the husband of Patricia M. Miller Neidlinger. On August 4th, they celebrated their 62nd wedding anniversary.

Born in Ebenezer on May 4, 1927, he was the son of the late Robert & Mary Krall Neidlinger. He had been a truck driver for the former Sprecher Trucking in Lebanon and later owned and operated his own truck. He was a veteran of the US Army during WW II.

He was a member of the Jonestown American Legion Post #883 and had served as Post Commander, the past Chef de Gare of 40 et 8 Voiture 55, Lebanon, and a member of the Myerstown VFW. For many years he volunteered with the American Legion Honor Guard.
