



Robert H. 'Pepper' Martin

Robert H. "Pepper" Martin, 85, of 141 E. Walnut Street, Cleona died Saturday May 10, 2014 in the M. S. Hershey Medical Center. He was the husband of Gladys Meyer Martin to whom he was married 60 years.

Born in Elizabethtown on December 15, 1928, he was the son of the late Emmett L. and Irene Heilman Martin. He was a retired Maintenance and Operations Foreman at the M. S. Hershey Medical Center with 17 years of service. In his earlier years, he was the owner of Robert H. Martin Electrical Service for 19 years.

Pepper was a U.S. Army veteran of WWII, a 1946 graduate of Lebanon High School and the Philadelphia School of Electricity.

He was a member of Hill Lutheran Church where he was instrumental in building the Church Fellowship Hall, Mt. Lebanon Lodge #226 F. &A.M., BPOE Elks #631, Lebanon, and a life member of the Cleona Fire Company where he served as a former chief.
