Robert Ray Soliday, 65, of Lebanon died Saturday January 30, 2010 at his residence. Born in Windsor Locks, CT on April 2, 1944 he was the son of the late Robert S. and Mary E. Camasta Soliday. Bob was a 1962 graduate of Lebanon High School and a veteran serving in the U.S. Army. He was the owner of Soliday's Auto Sales in Cleona. He also was proprietor of a gun shop called the Second Hand Hunter during the 1980s. He was an accomplished artist and enjoyed painting, poetry and acting. Bob also enjoyed composing songs one making the top 20 Country Billboard charts with "I'm Only A Woman" in 1981. He was known for writing "The Blue Eyed Six" song during the 1970s.
