June 30, 1940 - May 12, 2011

Rodney L. "Rod" Hoover, 70, of Jonestown died on Thursday May 12, 2011 at his home. Born in Stouchsburg on June 30, 1940 he was the son of the late Warren W. Hoover and Ruth D. Klopp. He graduated from Conrad Weiser High School in 1957. Rodney was a member Tulpehocken Reformed Church. Rod was an archery shooter for 40 to 45 years, he was 4th best archer in the world in 1982, and he held 2 National Archery Association world records, traveled all over the world, he is in the archery hall of fame and still holds many state and regional records. Rod helped with Boy Scout archery at Camp Bashore. Trish and Glen Gray were very close friends of Rodney who watched over him during his last few years. He is survived by a daughter Kelly wife of Rick Smith of Myerstown; a brother David Hoover of Clear Brook VA; two grandchildren Jenna wife of Derek Reich and Jade Smith and one great-grandchild Lincoln Reich. A memorial service will be held on Sunday May 22 at 2pm at Camp Bashore Boy Scout Reservation 160 Moonshine Rd Jonestown, PA 17038. Inurnment will be at the convenience of the family.
