Ronald E. "Ron" Elliott, 81, of Palmyra, passed away at his residence on Friday October 8, 2021 at his residence. He was the husband of Marlene K. (Flory) Elliott, with whom he celebrated 53 years in marriage in August of this year.

Ron was born in Lebanon on September 19, 1940 to the late Paul S. and Emma (Miller) Elliott. He was a US Army Veteran of the Vietnam War. He was a conductor for the Conrail/Norfolk Southern Railroad.
