Ronald R. "Zip" Zimmerman, 77, of 110 Clay Court, Annville died Sunday August 23, 2015 in his residence. He was the husband of Constance E. May Zimmerman with whom he celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary this past December.

Born in Annville on July 18, 1938, he was the son of the late Harvey C. and Violet Fasnacht Zimmerman. He was a retired Plant Superintendent from Double H. Boot Company, Womelsdorf after 44 years of service and served in the Pennsylvania National Guard for 13 years.

He deeply loved and was proud of all his grandchildren and followed their sporting activities around the state.
