Russell E. Horner, 87, of Jonestown, passed away on Sunday, July 25, 2021, at his home surrounded by his loving family. He was the husband of Carol K. Harpster Horner who was the love of his life. On March 1st, they celebrated their 64th wedding anniversary.

Born in Baree Twp., Huntingdon County, on August 27, 1933, he was the son of the late Daniel A. and Hazel Wilson Horner. Russell retired in 1988, after serving as the Postmaster at the Lebanon Post Office. He was a U.S. Air Force veteran of the Korean Conflict. He was a member of the Jonestown United Methodist Church, the Jonestown and Fredericksburg American Legions, the Mt. Zion Fire Co., and the Lewistown Kiwanis Club.
