



## Russell E. Schott

April 30, 1925 - May 14, 2013

Russell E. Schott, Sr., 88, of Fredericksburg, passed away on Tuesday, May 14, 2013, at the Lebanon Good Samaritan Hospital. He was the husband of Sara J.
