SallyAnn Arndt, 81, passed away peacefully at home on Friday, March 14, 2025 with her family by her side.

She was born in Rutherford Heights, Pennsylvania on June 14, 1943 and grew up in Palmyra, Pennsylvania. At 16 years old, she started waitressing at Arndt's Sub Base in Hershey and met her future husband, Lester.
