Samuel Kenneth Wenger, 70, of Lebanon, passed away Monday October 6, 2025, at Carolyn's House (Carolyn Croxton Slane Residence).

Born in Lebanon, he was the son of Arlene R. (Heisey) Wenger of Annville and the late Samuel Wenger.
