



## Sanford E. "Sandy" Newman, Sr.

April 10, 1947 - March 29, 2022

Sanford E. "Sandy" Newman, Sr., 74, of Lebanon, passed away on Tuesday, March 29, 2022, at his home surrounded by his loving family. He was the husband of Melody A. Miller Newman. On August 25th, they would have celebrated their 43rd wedding anniversary.

Born in Mt. Union on April 10, 1947, he was the son of the late Sanford S. and Mary Harmon Newman. Sandy had served for nearly eight years in the U.S. Air Force and he served during the Vietnam Conflict. After seventeen years, he retired from Brentwood Industries in Lebanon where he had been the shipping supervisor. He was a member of the Trinity United Methodist Church, Lickdale. He was also a life member of the DAV, the VVA Harrisburg Chapter #542, the American Legion, VFW and the Huntingdon County Sports Hall of Fame.
