September 12, 1966 - January 16, 2022

Scott A. Gingrich, 55, of Lebanon, passed away on Sunday, January 16, 2022, at the Hershey Medical Center. He was the husband of Lisa M. Miller Gingrich. On October 27th, they celebrated their 21st wedding anniversary. Born in Lebanon on September 12, 1966, he was the son of Gary L. and Alberta Sterner Gingrich of Fredericksburg. For 32 years Scott had worked for Verl's Salads, his family's business. Following the sale of the business, he worked for Bell & Evans. He was an active and faithful member of the Lebanon Area Evangelical Free Church in Jonestown. He served on the praise team, as an usher, and was also on the church softball team. He especially enjoyed and loved spending time with his family and friends. In addition to his wife and his parents, he is survived by his daughter Madeline Grace Gingrich at home; brother Keith husband of Robin Gingrich of Jonestown; his sister Krista wife of Andy Krouse of Myerstown; and his father-in-law Ronald M. Miller of Lebanon.

A Celebration of Life service will be held at 3:00 p.m. on Sunday, January 30, 2022, at the Lebanon Area Evangelical Free Church, 600 Shepherd St., Jonestown. There will be a time of fellowship and visiting with the family following the service. Masks are strongly encouraged.

“As a little girl, I remember following Scott and Keith around to their hiding places outside Dot and Verl’s while playing hide-n-seek. As I grew up, I followed them around the yard playing wiffle ball and football, and the driveway for games of P-I-G and H-O-R-S-E. In the winter, I’d follow their sleds down Windy Hill. In those days, unless I was tattling, it was never just Scotty, it was always Scott and Keith, and for the most part, they always let me follow them. In my pre-teen years, I remember a very significant day, when I dedicated my life to Christ and followed Scott into the baptismal pond at the Jesus festival. Then I was a part of the youth fellowship and Adonai choir, which some have already mentioned on here. During choir, Scott sang, along with many others, “I don’t want to be, I don’t want to be a casual Christian...” He certainly wasn’t! The choir ended each event with the song *Friends* by Michael W. Smith, which seems especially appropriate for this occasion.
