



## Shirley M. Long

September 11, 1933 - July 9, 2013

Shirley M. Long, 79, of Cornwall and formerly of Cleona died Tuesday, July 9, 2013 at the Good Samaritan Hospital. She was the wife of Robert L. Long with whom she celebrated their 54th wedding anniversary this past January. Born in Wilkinsburg on September 11, 1933 she was the daughter of the late Raymond and C. Marie Stoops Crawford.
