



## Sondra S. Gepfer

March 7, 1936 - January 4, 2016

Sondra S. Gepfer, 79, of Campbelltown died Monday January 4, 2016 in the home of her sister in Fredericksburg. She was the wife of Carl R. Gepfer to whom she was married 53 years.

Born in Harrisburg on March 7, 1936, she was the daughter of the late Earl and Catherine Arva Smith. She was employed in the personnel department at Hershey Foods Corp. for 39 years. She was also a part time news correspondent for the Lebanon Daily News.

Sondra was a 1954 graduate of Hershey High School and Hershey Junior College. She was a member of Campbelltown United Methodist Church where she sang in the choir and taught Bible School. In her earlier years, she was a member of the Palmyra Women's Club, an active volunteer for the Palmyra Public Library and served on its Board of Directors, a volunteer for the Children's Miracle Network, and participated in fundraising for WITF. Sondra was also an avid Penn State fan and enjoyed quilting and sewing.
