January 1, 1935 - May 25, 2015

Sonn Doeur, 80, of Cleona, passed away on May 25, 2015, at Good Samaritan Hospital, Lebanon surrounded by family and friends. Sonn was born in Cambodia to the late Din Doeur (father) and Soth Pich (mother). Sonn was preceded in death by her husband Lem Men, her daughter Sokhon Men, and four siblings.

Sonn arrived in the United States at Fort Indiantown Gap in 1975 with her daughter and her family after the fall of Saigon and the subsequent rise of the Khmer Rouge in Cambodia. Their family and many other Cambodian refugees were sponsored by Jean and Charles Henry III.

She lived with her daughter, son-in-law and their two sons. She helped run the household and raise her grandsons. She was well-known for her brutal honesty and laughter amongst her grandson's friends. She enjoyed gardening and watching TV game shows such as "The Price is Right," and "Wheel of Fortune." She was also a devout member of the Phra Buddha Ransi Temple in Philadelphia.

Sonn is survived by her daughter, Lundy, wife of Sarin Mam of Cleona. She is also survived by her two grandsons: Makara Mam of Cleona, and Sovanna Mam of Harrisburg and his wife Kristen and their son Elijah. She is also survived by her sister Soy Doeur of Cambodia. She is also survived by her

sister-in-law Onn Mam of Hershey, and her daughter Prolung O'Donnell (Ngin), wife of Bob O'Donnell and their son Nolan. She is also survived by her niece Phalkun Top of Lowell, MA, her husband Rithy Oung and their daughter Krisna.
