



## Stanley E. Hartzell

June 9, 1933 - June 13, 2023

Stanley E. Hartzell, 90, of Pine Grove and formerly of Jonestown, passed away on Tuesday, June 13, 2023, at the Tremont Health & Rehabilitation Center. He was the husband of Catherine B. Fedosh Hartzell. On October 19th, they celebrated their 65th wedding anniversary.

Born in Ft. Meade, MD on June 9, 1933, he was the son of the late Charles and Edna Miller Hartzell. Following high school, he served in the U.S. Navy during the Korean Conflict on the USS Dionysus. Stanley worked as a Management Analyst for the Federal Government. Following his retirement, he worked for Fulton Bank. He was a member of Our Lady of Fatima Chapel, the DAV, VFW, and American Legion. He was an avid Eagles fan and never missed watching a game. He loved lighthouses, and, along with his wife, they visited over one hundred-fifty of them.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by his sons David J. and his wife Fay Hartzell of Port Matilda, Daniel S. and his wife Nancy Hartzell of Annville and Joseph S. and his wife Shirley Hartzell of New Berlin; daughter Susan E. wife of John Breidenstine of Schuylkill Haven; eight grandchildren and ten great grandchildren; and sister Sandy Hartzell of Somerville, NJ.

He was preceded in death by two brothers and three sisters.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, June 22, 2023, at Our Lady of Fatima Chapel, Rt. 22 & N. Mill St., Jonestown. There will be a visitation on Wednesday evening from 6:00-8:00 p.m. at Creamer & Lum Funeral Home & Crematory, Jonestown. Interment with military honors

will follow the Mass at Indiantown Gap National Cemetery.
