Rev. Stanley M. Phillips, 77, of Jonestown, passed away on Monday, April 21, 2014, at Spang Crest Manor. He was the husband of Frances E. Daehling Phillips.

Born in Trenton, NJ on August 21, 1936, he was the son of the late Stanley M. and Dorothy (maiden name) Phillips. In 1958 he graduated from the Wagner Lutheran College, Staten Island and graduated from the Philadelphia Lutheran Theological Seminary in 1962. In 1998, Rev.
