He was a 1978 graduate of Annville-Cleona High School; a member of St. Paul the Apostle Church, Annville, the Annville American Legion Post 559, and the Union Hose Fire Company Social Club. He enjoyed playing softball and golf. Surviving in addition to his wife are a son Zachary S. Johnson at home, two daughters Heather L. wife of Luke E. Leininger of Annville, Ashley M. Johnson of Cleona, a brother John E. Johnson, Jr. of Prescott, and a sister Nancy wife of Barry Hartman of Cleona.
