Steven D. "Steve" Light, 70, of Lebanon passed away on Wednesday March 29, 2023 at Select Specialty Hospital in Harrisburg. Steve was the husband of Vickie M. (Minnich) Light, with whom he would have celebrated 49 years in marriage this coming June.

Steve was born in Lebanon on August 17, 1952 to the late Thomas Light, Sr., and June (Dundore) Light.
