Tam Chon Luong (64), of Lebanon, passed away on Saturday, September 10, 2016 at 6:05pm. He was the husband of Thu-Thuy Thi Lam. Born in Vietnam on October 27, 1951, he was the son of the late Ha Thuc Luong and Nho Le. Tam moved with his wife and two children to the Lebanon area in the early 1980's. Tam retired from M&M and Mars in Elizabethtown in 2011, after 20 years of work. Tam was a member of the Vietnamese Catholic community of Lebanon, where he enjoyed singing with the choir. He also enjoyed singing and playing guitar outside of church. He was skilled in carpentry, building many things for the home, and he was great with all things home improvement. He loved spending time with family and friends. He and his wife enjoyed traveling the world. His humor and kindness endeared him to many people. Surviving in addition to his wife is a son, Khiet Cao Luong and wife Theresa Tuyet Hoang, and their son Xavier Duc Hoang Luong; a daughter, Nguyet-Que (Sue) Thi Luong and her husband Bryan Robert Thomas, and their children Riggs Tam Thomas, Cole Loc Thomas and Layne Ri Thomas.
