Terry A. Beers, 67, of Myerstown (Arbor Gate Community), passed away on Wednesday, October 19th, 2016 at Stoneridge Towne Centre. He was the husband of Bonnie L. (Hodel) Beers. They celebrated their 45th wedding anniversary on November 27th, 2015.
