Terry Lee Haines, 70, of Palmyra, passed away on February 18, 2016 at M.S. Hershey Medical Center. He was the husband of Carole J. Addis Haines, with whom he celebrated 45 years in marriage.

Born in Reading on January 21, 1946, he was the son of the late Jesse and Ruth Arnold Haines. Terry was a 1964 graduate of Exeter Twp. High School and a 1968 graduate of Penn State University. He also studied law at Temple University. He was a management analyst with the PA State Department of Transportation where he supervised the forms management division. Terry proudly served as a 1st Lt. with the US Army during the Vietnam Conflict. He was awarded the Purple Heart, the Bronze Star, the Vietnam Service Medal and the Vietnam Campaign Medal. He also received the Army Commendation Medal and the National Defense Service Medal. After serving with the US Army he then served as Capt. in the Pennsylvania National Guard where he was decorated with General Steward Service Medal and the Pennsylvania Service Medal.

Terry was an avid sports fan. He followed the Philadelphia Phillies and the Philadelphia Eagles. His greatest love was Penn State Football. He enjoyed coaching soccer, track and field, and baseball. He had a love for little league baseball, where he was an umpire.

Terry enjoyed studying history, especially the Civil War and WWII and he also had a coin collection that he treasured.

It was at 8:35AM, every day, when Terry would talk with Larry Spayd. Larry was a high school friend and then a college roommate. They then became Penn State Football season ticket holders. It was a friendship they shared also during many rounds of golf.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by his daughter Laurie Haines of Lebanon, sons, Travis Haines of Selah, WA, Justin Haines of Annville, a grandson Matthew Lagrelius, raised by Terry and Carole, granddaughter Cheyenne Gettle, grandsons Jesse and Dylan Haines, and a brother Scott Haines. He is also is survived by his beagles, Jubie and Dusty.
