Thomas S. Willman, 74, of Lebanon passed away on Friday, November 29, 2024 at his residence. He was the husband of the late Barbara (Smith) Willman who passed away in 2003.

Born in Lebanon, he was the son of the late Stephen and Magdalen (Blum) Willman. He was a 1968 graduate of Lebanon Catholic High School. Tom was self-employed most of his life. For many years he created beautiful metal sculptures and participated in art shows along the east coast. Later in life he started his own landscaping business. He also enjoyed fishing, hunting and antiques. His greatest joy was spending time with family and friends.

Tom was a lifetime member of St. Cecilia's Catholic Church in Lebanon and attended mass several times a week when able.

Tom achieved over 34 years of sobriety and served as a mentor and sponsor to many individuals through his involvement with Alcoholics Anonymous. Even after years of sobriety, he prioritized his involvement in AA meetings.

Tom was a "helper". It is difficult to capture how many lives he touched through his caring outreach. Whether through offering guidance and support, financial assistance, or giving someone a place to stay, he was supportive to those in need.

He is survived by three daughters Audrey, wife of David Fortna, Crystal, wife of Kris Turner, and Jennifer, wife of Tony Rutter; seven grandchildren Madison, Brayden, Adam, Tasia, Caleb, Melayna, and Javion.

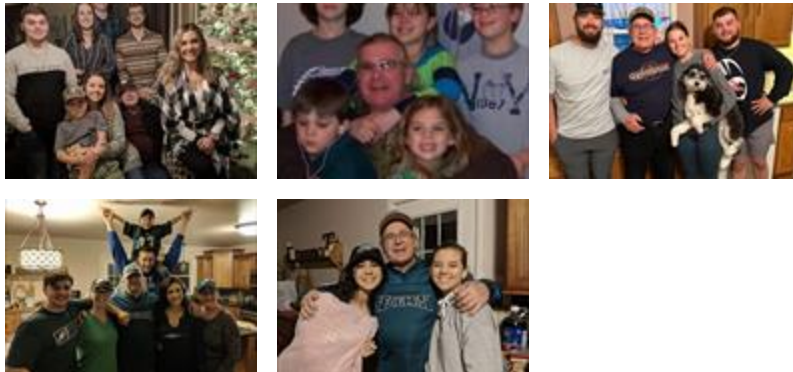
